**SEN. BROWN TO AWARD CONGRESSIONAL BADGE OF BRAVERY TO MORROW COUNTY DEPUTY SHERIFF ON THURSDAY**

MOUNT GILEAD, OH –U.S. Sen. Sherrod Brown (D-OH) and U.S. Rep. Jim Jordan will award the Congressional Badge of Bravery for heroism to Morrow County Deputy Sheriff Brandon Moore, who was wounded in the line of duty in October 2010.

Deputy Moore, a nine-year veteran of the Sheriff's office, was struck five times by open fire in an incident that occurred south of Mount Gilead. Despite his immediate injuries, Deputy Moore disabled the attacker, which saved lives and led to three arrests and seizure of marijuana and firearms.

Moore is one of only 21 law enforcement officials in the nation being honored with the 2010 Congressional Badge of Bravery.
