On Friday, I had the honor and privilege of presenting the [Congressional Badge of Bravery](#) to Officer Eduardo Espinoza, a Seventh District constituent and proud member of the DeKalb County Police Department. The Badge of Bravery is awarded by the highest ranking law enforcement official in the country, the United States Attorney General, to local law enforcement officers who engage in “exceptional acts of bravery while in the line of duty.” Officer Espinoza and his colleague are the first from Georgia to ever receive this national award.
